The year 2020 -2021 was the year that posed a challenge for each section of society. Scientists and doctors had to double their efforts to make people come out of covid times safely. On another front schools and colleges took the charge of educating every child by all means. Our school too stepped up to meet the challenge of making education feasible to every child sitting at home.

Teachers took classes through Zoom, Google Meet and made learning easy for them. Complete digitization of the school was done to facilitate the teachers talking about school results Class X and XII has hundred pass percentage.

In class X the highest score in English, Hindi is 99 whereas in Science, Mathematics, S.ST, Information Technology it's a perfect 100. The overall highest mark is 99.60percent.

In class XII highest score in English, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education is 98; in Physics, Mathematics, Hindustani Music Vocal , Business Studies it is 99; for Economics, Accountancy it is 97 and in Informatics Practices it is 95. The Highest score of Medical Stream is 97.40%; Non-Medical Stream is 98.40% and Commerce is 97.60%.

In this rapid digital and technological world, it's a great opportunity for the students of SHCS as “Artificial Intelligence”, Robotics has been introduced for classes 4th to 12th.

We are also a center for spot evaluation of class 10 and 12 this year in the month of June and we completed the task successfully.
