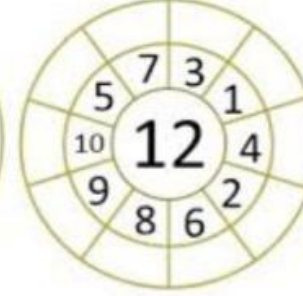
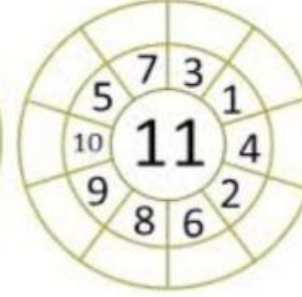
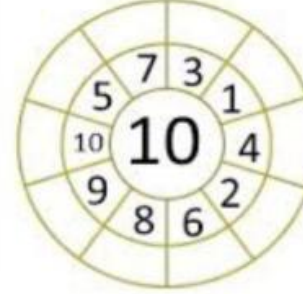
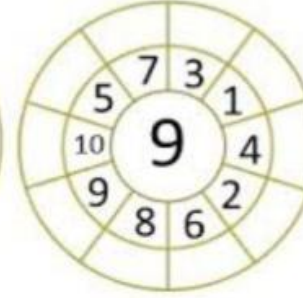
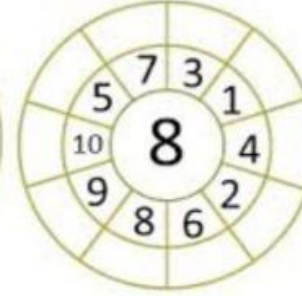
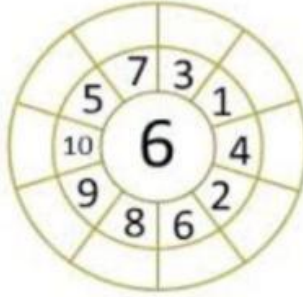
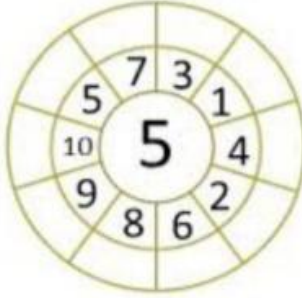
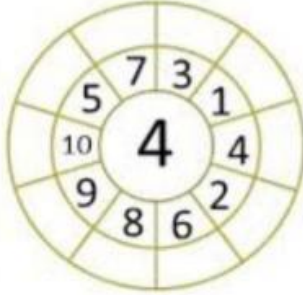
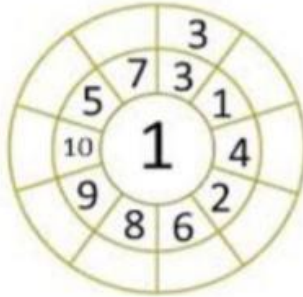
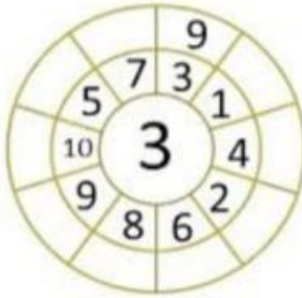
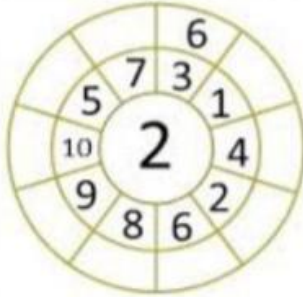


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Worksheet 2

Multiply the numbers by the centre number.



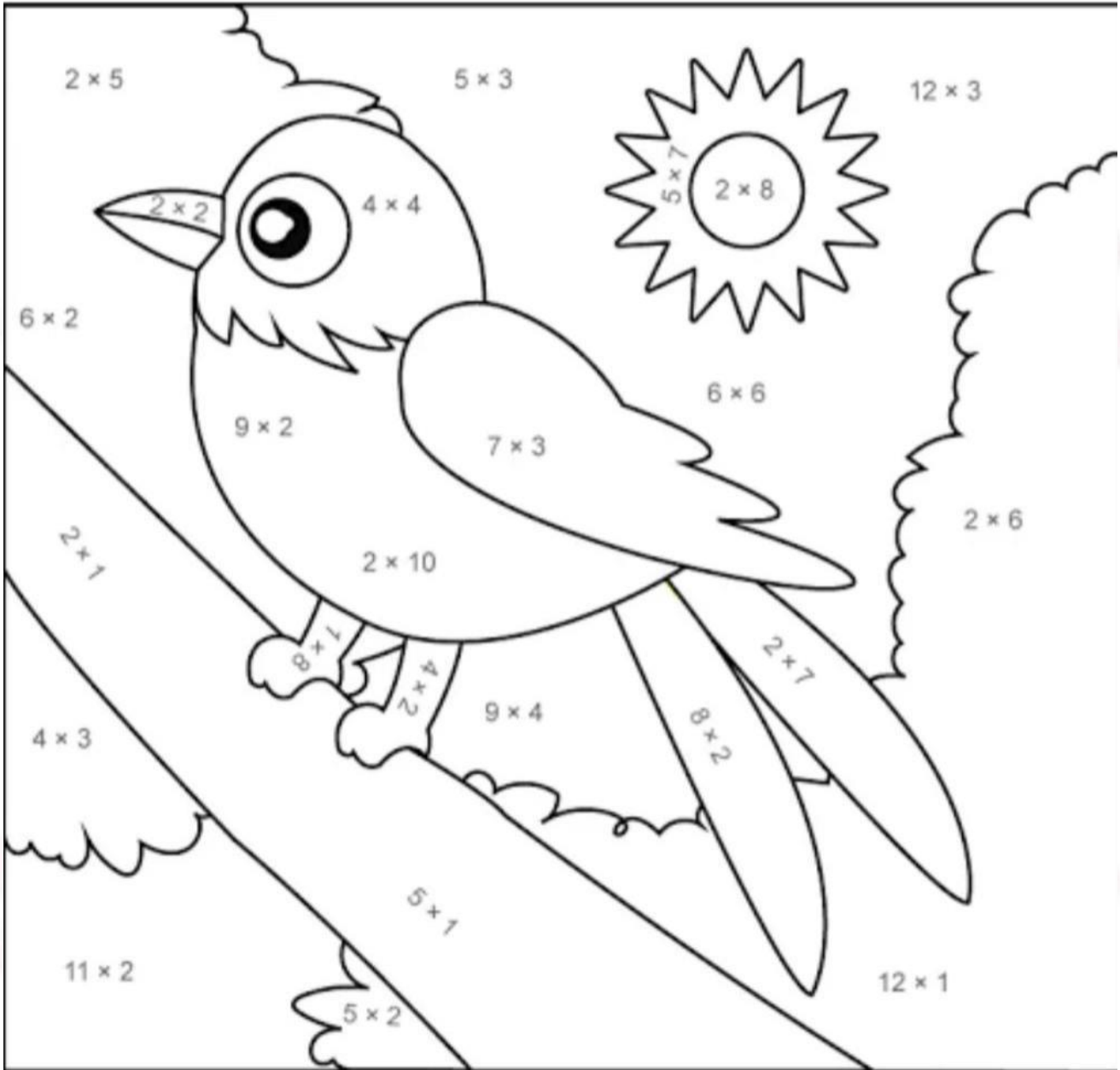
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Multiplication Coloring Worksheet
